

AND WHEREAS each of the parties hereto of the "Other Part" has individually or jointly has agreed to act as Trustees of the Trust, Proposed by the party of the first part.

AND WHEREAS nothing contained in this deed shall be deemed to authorize the trustees to do any which may in any way be construed statutory modifications thereof and all activities of the trust shall be carried out with a view of benefit the public at large, without any profit motive and in accordance with provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any statutory modifications thereof.


AND WHEREAS the trust is hereby expressly declared to be a public charitable trust and all the provisions of this deed are to be constituted accordingly.




2. NAME:

The name of the Trust shall be **GOOD LUCK FOUNDATION.**

3. PLACE:

The principal office of the Trust shall be situated at WEST MOHAN BIGHA, DALMIANAGAR, DEHRI-ON-SONE, DISTRICT: - ROHTAS. The TRUSTEES shall be at liberty to transfer the office or may open branch or branches at any place and/or places within the territories of India at their mutual consent /decision or majority from time to time in the best interest of TRUST.

4. OBJECTS TO BE PURSUED BY THE TRUST:

- a. Educational – to run, maintain or assist any educational or other Institution for primary/middle/higher education, Coaching, Guidance counseling or vocational training or to grant individual scholarship for poor, deserving and needy students for elementary and higher education.
- b. Establishment and maintenance of Hostels and /or Boarding for students and Trainers.
- c. Establishment of Institution related to environmental activities, games and sports.
- d. Medical – to run, maintain or assist any medical institution, nursing home or clinics or to grant assistance to needy and indigent persons for meeting the cost of medical treatment.
- e. Vocational Courses and Technical Courses- To run and/or maintain institution related to vocational courses and Technical Courses.
- f. B.Ed. and other Training Courses-To run and/or maintain Institution
- g. Other objects of general public utility:-
 - i. To acquire property for the sole use for public good by making it available for public purpose as for example. Housing a library, clinic, crèche and/ or as a community hall to be available for public use as training classes, seminars,

discourses and other public functions for benefit of the community in general.

- ii. To help farmer, labours, rural, artisan and youth in obtaining facilities as required
- iii. To undertake any other activity incidental to the above activities as may be decided by the Board of Trustees time to time but which are not inconsistent with the above objects.

Provided the trust may assist/donate, the other trust to carry out the various objects mentioned in the objects clause in such manner and to the extent the trustees may decide upon from time to time.

5. FUNDS:


The Trustees may accept donations, grants, subscriptions, aids or contributions from any person, Government, Local authorities or any other charitable institutions, in cash or in kind including immovable property without any encumbrance, but the Trustees shall not accept any receipt with any condition or terms inconsistent with the objects of the Trust. While applying such receipts to the objects, the Trustees shall respect the directions, if any, by granter. Any receipt with specific direction to treat the same as part of the corpus of the Trust or separate fund shall be funded accordingly.

6. INVESTMENTS:

- i. All moneys, which shall not immediately required for current needs shall be invested by the Trustees in eligible securities and investments, or in banks. Such investments shall be in the name of the Trust of the Trustees.
- ii. That the trustees shall invest the trust fund; carry on any business with the trust fund and/ or enter into partnership on behalf of the trust, as they may deem fit.
- iii. That the trustees shall manage the trust fund and investments thereof as prudent man would do the same. They shall recover all outstanding and meet all recurring and other expenses incurred in the upkeep or management thereof.

8. BOARD OF TRUSTEES:


That the Board of Trustees shall mean and include the First Trustees of these presents survivor or survivors of them and the Trustees for the time -being these presents

9. COMPOSITION OF TRUST :

- a) General Body
- b) Executive Committee

GENERAL BODY

- a) The General body will consist of all kinds of members of Trust
- b) Meeting of the general body – The general body of the trust shall meet at least once in a year at such place as the executive Committee may decide. Any special meeting of general body may be called whenever necessary.
- c) Every member shall be entitled to receive invitation of meeting 15 days prior to the meeting day, but urgent meeting can be called on short notice.
- d) Quorum: – One quarter of total membership of the trust shall form the quorum of the general body of the trust.



EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

- a) The Executive Committee shall comprise of minimum 3 members including office bearers 1) Chairman 2) Secretary cum treasurer 3) one member.

- b) Meetings – The Executive Committee shall meet at least twice a year at such time and place as Chairman may decide.

11. DUTIES OF THE OFFICE BEARERS

- (a) The Chairman: - The Chairman of the trust shall be the Chairman of all the meetings of the trust and would be over all in charge of the trust.
- (b) In the absence of the Chairman the one of the trustees as decided by remaining trustees shall preside over the meetings and perform such other duties which are performed by the chairman.
- (c) The duties of Secretary shall be:-
 - (i) To implement administrator and carry out the approved programs and activities of the trust. He will also be empowered to initiate and undertake programs whenever necessary.
 - (ii) To keep records of the proceeding of all the meetings of the trust and necessary information pertaining to their activities.
 - (iii) To carry on correspondence on behalf and to have the custody of the records and file of the trust.
 - (iv) To maintain regular accounts. Proper periodical reports and statements of accounts of the trust to the Executive committee and general body.

- (v) To borrow on the behalf of the trust after due authorization of the Executive committee funds or loans from financial and or lending institutions.

12. POWERS OF APPOINT COMMITTEES:


The Board of Trustees shall be entitled from time to time to appoint with or without remuneration and on such terms and conditions as they may think proper, to appoint committee as they may think proper to function under the authority and control of the Trustees for carrying out the objects of the trust of these presents or the management thereof and invest them with all such powers including power to incur all such expenditure as may be necessary for carrying out the objects of the trust.

13. POWER TO COMPROMISE:

The Board of Trustees shall have full powers to settle compromise or compound, out of court, all suits, actions and other proceedings and to settle all or other proceedings, difference of demand and adjust the settlement of all accounts relating thereof as fully as if they were absolutely entitled to the trust fund and without being answerable for the loss occasioned thereby.

14. POWER TO PURCHASE, HIRE OR TAKE ON LEASE:

The Board of Trustees shall be entitled to purchase or hire or to take on lease a property or properties for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the Trust hereby created.



15. POWER TO BORROW:

The Trustees may from time to time, at their discretion for the furtherance and carrying out the objects of the Trust of these PRESENTS, borrow such sums as may be determined by the Board of Trustees from time to time in form and manner thereupon. The Trustee shall, at their discretion, make all such dispositions of the properties movable or immovable forming part of the Trust Fund or any part thereof and enter into such agreements, assurances and things in relation thereto as the trustees may deem proper for giving security for such loans & interest.

16. POWERS OF TRUSTEES:

That the trustees shall have following powers;

- i. To manage all the assets and/or properties of the trust including the conduct of business.
- ii. To appoint employees and to settle the terms of their service, remuneration and terminations.
- iii. To look into the management of the trust.
- iv. To invest the fund of the trust, in bank or in purchase of company shares or securities or other movable and immovable properties.
- v. To sell, alter, vary, transpose or otherwise dispose or alienate the properties or any investments representing the same for consideration and to reinvest the same.
- vi. To pledge or mortgage the trust properties for raising loans.
- vii. To open the bank accounts in the name and on behalf of the trust and to operate the same.
- viii. To enter into a partnership on behalf of the trust with any other party or parties.
- ix. To pay all charges, impositions and other outgoing payable in respect of the trust properties and also to pay all cost of the incidental to the administration and management of the trust properties.
- x. To file suit on behalf of the trust and to refer to arbitration all actions, proceedings and disputes touching the trust properties and to compromise and compound the suits filed.
- xi. To accept any gift, donation or contribution in cash or in kind from anyone for the objects of the trust.

- xii. To seek legal opinion of lawyers and/or chartered accountants as and when required.
- xiii. To nomination their representatives for any of the aforesaid purposes.

- 17. The number of trustees shall not be less than two.
- 18. Every trustee will be at liberty to nominate or appoint attorneys or agents and to delegate all or any of the duties and powers vested in him to such attorney or agent, and to remove such attorney or agent and reappoint other or others in his place.
- 19. No trustees shall be responsible or liable for any loss or any act of omission or commission by his constituted attorney or agent or employees or other trustees unless occasioned by his willful neglect or default.
- 20. Any of the trustees may retire on giving one month's notice in writing to the other trustee(s).
- 21. If any trustee dies or retires or becomes incapable or unfit to act, the continuing or surviving trustee or trustee shall appoint a successor in the place of such trustee.
- 22. If at any time the number of the trustees is less than two, the existing trustee shall appoint one or more trustees.
- 23. Upon the appointment of a new trustee the trust properties shall vest in the new trustee jointly with continuing or surviving trustees, with the duties and power of the trustees set out herein above in this deed.
- 24. If the trust is determined by efflux of time, the corpus of the trust shall be divided amongst the beneficiaries in the shares as fixed by the trustees.

25. BANKING ACCOUNT:

All income, subscription and pecuniary donations for the general purposes of the trust and the income, investments and all other moneys from time to time forming part of the general revenue of the trust shall on the same being received be paid into banking account with any scheduled bank for the purpose of the trust. The bank accounts shall be jointly OR singly operated by the Chairman and/or the Secretary cum Treasurer.

26. The trustee shall keep proper books of account of all the assets, liabilities and income and expenditure of the trust and shall prepare an income and expenditure account and balance sheet for every year as on the last day of March.

- The accounts of every year shall be audited by a chartered accountant or a firm of chartered accountants who shall be appointed for that purpose by the trustees and the audited accounts shall be placed at a meeting of the trustees, which shall be held before the end of the succeeding year.

27. IRREVOCABLE:

This trust is irrevocable.

28. AMALGAMATION:

The trustees may amalgamate the trust with another charitable trust or institution having similar objects with prior permission of the charity; commissioner/court/any other law as may be applicable for the time being.


29. WINDING UP:

some other similar Trust/organization whose objects are similar to those of this trust with permission of the charity commissioner/court/any other law as may be applicable for the time being.


The trustees shall be indemnified against all losses and liabilities by them in execution of the trust and shall have a lien over the funds and properties of the trust for such indemnity.
